Funding is available under two categories. Applicants may apply for funding for:

- 1) Community Sporting Clubs
- 2) Community Training Camps & Programs

3.1 COMMUNITY SPORTING CLUBS

The amount for community sporting clubs or individual sporting sponsorship is capped at \$10,000 per application. Funding can be used towards the following costs:

- o Equipment
- Uniforms
- o Training camps or competitions fees, including travel and accommodation

Terms and Conditions

- Funding must benefit the Community.
- Individual Sponsorship applicants must reside in community and be representing their region.
- Applications will be considered on a case by case basis.
- Funding must be for the enhancement of physical well-being.
- Applicants must provide details of how funds are to be used.
- Applicants can only apply for equipment every three (3) years, and it is up to applicants to house and maintain the equipment.
- Uniforms can only be purchased every two (2) years.
- Applicants can only apply for funding once per year.
- Funding must be paid to suppliers, not to individuals.
- Funding can provide for special sporting activities for the aged to assist with the types of physical limitations that can be suffered by aged persons.
- Funding must be acquitted per the Grant Acquittal Policy and Procedure.
- Applicants must acknowledge the CSRT for its funding support.
- Funding must be used in the respective calendar year and will not be rolled over unless there is an approved application for an extension.
